(c) in cases where the owner gives His Majesty a lien Lands where creating a first charge upon the lands, subject only to for payment taxes, for the sum of one dollar for each acre of such lands of one dollar included in such patent or sale, payable in five acreal included in such patent or sale, payable in five equal annual instalments with interest at the rate of five per centum per annum from the first day of June, 1915, the first of such instalments and interest to be due and payable on the first day of June, 1916, such lien to be effected by an endorsement of the lien or a caveat respecting same on the Certificate of Title issued to the owner by the District Registrar of the proper Land Titles Office: Provided that such lien may be paid in full at any time during the said five years with interest as

aforesaid to the date of payment.

The Certificate of the Deputy Superintendent Discharge of General of Indian Affairs certifying that a lien has been lies. paid and satisfied shall be a valid discharge of such lien.

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on Act retrothe first day of June, A.D., 1915.
